

General Hazmat Marking and Labeling Requirements

- 1. Labels must be printed on or attached to a surface of the package other than the bottom
- 2. All labels must be located on the same surface (if possible) ideally near the proper shipping name
- 3. Primary and secondary labels must be displayed next to and within six inches of each other
- 4. Labels must be on a background of contrasting color OR have a dotted or solid line border
- 5. All labels must be clearly visible and cannot be blocked by other markings

Marking & Labeling

- 6. The following must be on the outside of your hazardous materials package or drum:
 - a. Proper shipping name
 - b. Identification number
 - c. Name and address of shipper and receiver
 - d. Hazard class label

Packaging

- 7. The box needs to have a UN symbol on it (in most cases)
- 8. The box must be structurally sound/intact
- 9. Markings on reused packages that don't apply to the original shipment need to be removed or blacked out
- 10. There are no rips where any tape was previously pulled off
